Start at Hosier Ln. located between Flinders Ln. and Flinders St. Start at the Federation Square end and walk your way uphill. Keep your eyes peeled for the rat.

Track 1: Hosier Lane – Sean M Whelan

At the top of the lane, turn left into Flinders Lane and walk down the hill to Swanston St. Cross the street to the Nicholas Building, Level 1, 35-37 Swanston St.

Track 2: Collected Works Bookstore – Maurice McNamara

Head back out onto Swanston St, then turn left and walk away from Flinders St Station towards Collins St. City Square is on the corner of Collins and Swanston Sts.

Track 3: City Square – Eleanor J Jackson

Keep walking away from Flinders St Station towards Little Collins St, turn left at Little Collins and walk towards Elizabeth St. Union Ln. is about 50 metres down the street on your right of Little Collins St.
