Poetry Walk 6 - Aqua Map

Surrounded by the chaos of the marketplace, look for teenagers with infected ear piercings. You might not find them, but at least you'll have a hot jam donut. Maybe they're waiting for you, sunbaking on the lawns and checking their phones. Either that, or they're shopping their little hearts out for the Queen's Jubilee. We could be completely wrong, maybe they've just taken their red capes to escape the rain. Who knows. How do you remember it?

Start at the Queen Victoria Market, corner Elizabeth and Victoria Sts. The market is open Tuesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday. You can go any day of the week if you like, but you'll miss the donuts on Mondays and Wednesdays.

Track 1: Queen Victoria Market – Steve Smart

Head east toward Elizabeth St and turn right at Elizabeth St. Walk approximately 400m then turn left at La Trobe St. Walk up La Trobe then turn right at Swanston Street Walk. The State Library is on the corner of Swanston and La Trobe Sts.

Track 2: State Library Lawns – Nathan Curnow

Head south on Swanston Street Walk toward Little Lonsdale St then turn left at Lonsdale St. The Queen Victoria Women's Centre Trust is located at 210 Lonsdale St and is a good place to start soaking up the shopping atmosphere.

Track 3: QV Building - Eleanor J Jackson

Head east on Lonsdale St toward Constance Stone Ln then turn right at Russell St. Turn right into Chinatown, Little Bourke St. Start running up towards Exhibition St if you're feeling fit.
