Poetry Walk 4 - Blue Map

Start on a side street and come and acknowledge the statue-less writers who live in dreams. Come edit your identity like generations before you, play with your hyphens in public. Start at the Wheeler Centre, 176 Little Lonsdale St, just around the corner from the State Library.

Track 1: Wheeler Centre – Steve Smart

Walk approximately 300m east on Little Lonsdale St. Turn right at Jones Ln and cross over Lonsdale St to continue on Jones Ln until you reach the Chinese Museum, 22 Cohen Place.

Track 2: Typography – Lia Incognita

Head south on Cohen Pl toward Little Bourke St then turn right into Chinatown, Little Bourke St. Turn left at Russell St and follow until you reach the Hungry Jacks on the corner of Bourke and Russell Sts.

Track 3: Dusk at the Golden Elbow – James Jackson

Head north on Russell St toward Bullens Ln back towards Chinatown. Turn left at Little Bourke St and follow it across Swanston and Elizabeth Sts until you reach 434/436 Little Bourke St (approximately 750m).

Track 4: City West Telephone Exchange – Bella Li

Head east on Little Bourke St toward St Johns Ln then turn right at Elizabeth St, follow Elizabeth St until the Bourke St Mall. If you're tired out from all this walking, take a seat on the The Public Purse opposite Melbourne's GPO.

Track 5: Perched on the Purse at Bourke St – Anthony O'Sullivan
